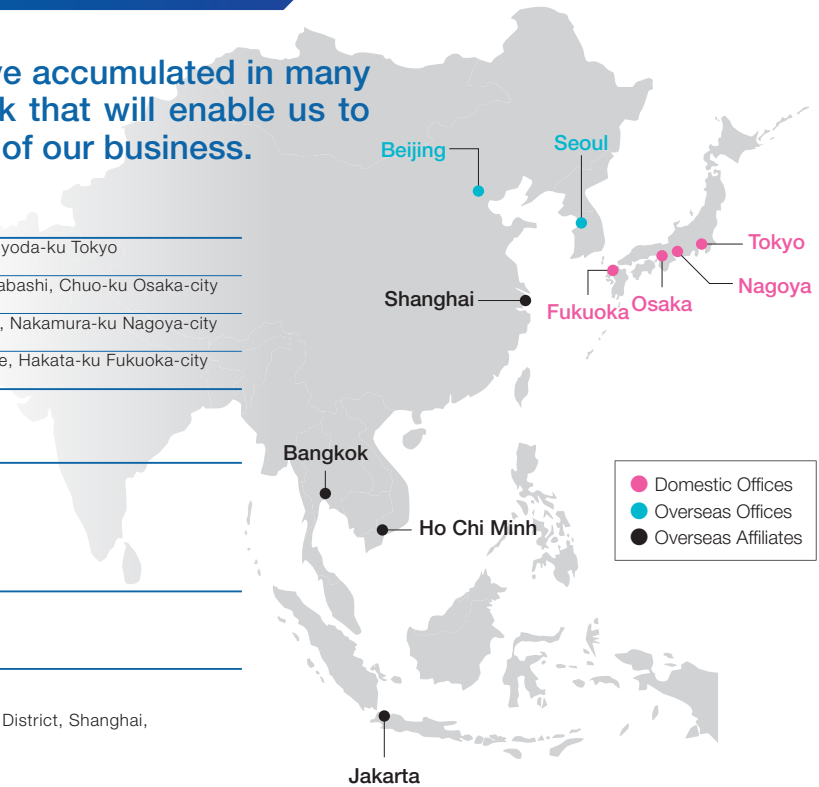

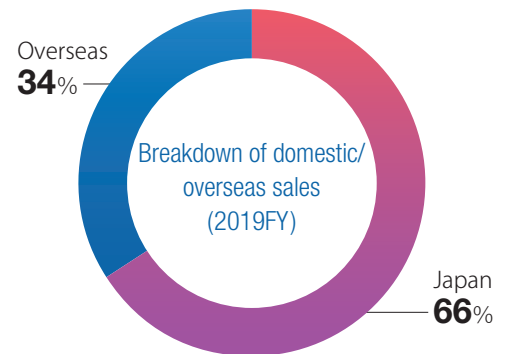

## Our China business represents 60 years of business know-how

Meiwa Corporation has a history of acting as a trading contact point with former communist bloc nations. In particular, having been designated a “friendly” trading company by China, it has used the sales and distribution basis, its information network and the trading know-how built over many years to develop the Chinese business so that it now makes up roughly one quarter of the Company's net sales. For the lubricant product trade in particular, Meiwa Corporation has been supported by its network, which is centered in Shanghai but also has more than 20 sales offices and 30 distribution bases throughout China. In addition, it operates a local factory as part of its joint venture with ENEOS.
